2024 Wise Skies Digital Calendar

Tap into the magic of good timing.

Here's what you can expect:

You will get three files: (1) 2023 astrology and numerology calendar, (2) Moon phases and ingresses, and (3) Moon Void of Course. *The files are separate so that you have the option to toggle them on/off as preferred.*

These calendars come in a universal format:

- Compatible with Google Calendar, iOS, Outlook, Android, and Mac
- Viewable on any device
- Work in any time zone – and even switch with you as you travel!

What's new?

In addition to the same great features as before, the 2024 calendar includes:

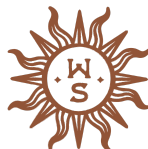
- Conjunctions now include signs and symbols
- Moon Phase family dates now include sabian symbols
- The descriptions now note that planets are retrograde when relevant
- Retroshade zones and Cazimis now have astro-emojis to help you learn astrology all year!

Data Disclaimer

The Astro data for this calendar was produced via Astrolabe's Solar Fire v9. With regard to retrograde, the calculation is the moment the longitudinal speed of a planet is less than 0 degrees. Retroshades are calculated when a planet enters or leaves the degree of the retrogradation in question. Keep in mind a slowing planet can be in a degree for several hours, please allow for adjustments. The calendar is produced in GMT and adjusts to your local time via the calendar function.

Pro-tip: The general Skies/forecast don't always match up with your personal transits or numerology. It's best to use this calendar as a loose frame of reference for the general energy available, while remembering to tune in to your own personal guidance system.

Installation Instructions

1. Start from the Checkout screen or open your email receipt
2. Click the links to download the calendar (.ics) files, DO NOT OPEN them yet
3. Create a **NEW** calendar in your calendar system called "Wise Skies" (THIS STEP IS VERY IMPORTANT)
4. Import the downloaded files into the Wise Skies calendar

If you're using an **Android phone or tablet** with Google Calendar, DO NOT install the calendars from your device! Follow the instructions for *Google Calendar* on Windows or Mac. The events will automatically sync to your Android device(s) signed into Google.

If you're using an **iPhone with Google Calendar**, DO NOT install the calendars from your iPhone! Follow the instructions for *Google Calendar* on Windows or Mac. The events will automatically sync to your iPhone and any other Apple device(s) signed into iCloud.

If you're using an **iPad**, follow the instructions for the iPhone. The process is identical.

* Note: The **Mac** tutorials begin at the checkout screen, but you can also begin with your confirmation email, using the links under "Download".

How to Uninstall

To remove the Wise Skies calendars from your calendar system, simply delete the “Wise Skies” calendar you created in Step 3 above. This process varies by device and operating system, so please see the *end* of the appropriate tutorial video above for detailed instructions.

Symbols Key

At a glance, you can now tell if it’s a good time to schedule something, *or not*. Pro-tip: Be sure to read the description of each calendar event for more information on when you will begin to feel the onset and relief of each event. This is summarized in “Timing of Transits” below.

✨ - Energy shifts, changing of the guards.

The sparkles indicate ingresses (when a planet changes signs), retrogrades (reverse motion), and when a planet returns direct (forward motion)

☀️ - Good times!

A Sun indicates general ease [schedule activities with confidence]. We use sextiles, trines, and conjunctions between planets with harmonic energies to tap into the magic of good timing.

☂️ - Slow down...

An Umbrella indicates tension in the Skies. Lay low, avoid big decisions and important conversations. In astrology, squares, some semisquares, oppositions, and conjunctions between two planets with intense energies indicate an area where you may experience a breakdown in order to have a breakthrough. If you’re going through a tough time, keep going. This is not an optimal time to start new projects, or put things into motion. Your mantra on Umbrella days: This too shall pass.

☀️☂️ - Potential and Mixed Mojo.

A Sun and an Umbrella combined indicate potential and mixed energy - it’s a good idea to look at what is going on in your personal chart and numerology for more information. We often use



these during conjunctions and semisquares between planets that have opposing energies, where more context is needed.

🌑🌒 - New Moon

This sign indicates a New Moon (we've included an emoji for the sign of the Moon too!) This is when the Moon is positioned between the Earth and Sun, making it invisible to us in the night Skies. This phase signifies new beginnings and is a great time to set intentions. Make wishes within the first 8 hours of the time the New Moon is exact.

☾♈ - First Quarter Moon

This sign indicates a First Quarter Moon (we've included an emoji for the sign of the Moon too!). This yang phase signifies decision making, determination, and commitment to action. In the Sky, you'll see exactly half of the Moon illuminated.

☀️♋ - Full Moon

This sign indicates a Full Moon (we've included an emoji for the sign of the Moon too!). The entire Moon is illuminated during this phase. This phase signifies the completion of a cycle, endings, and closure.

☾♏ - Last Quarter Moon

This sign indicates a Last Quarter Moon (we've included an emoji for the sign of the Moon too!). This yin phase signifies receptivity and a willingness to trust, surrender, and let things take their course. In the Sky, you'll see exactly half of the Moon illuminated.

What if there is conflicting advice on the same day?

Sometimes the cosmic wheel weaves multiple energies around the same time. The trick to understanding a set of conflicting energies lies within the scope and depth of each influence. How long will it last? What feels heavier right now, versus what feels heavier for a longer period of time. (How have we addressed this in the description notes?)

What does it mean when something has several passes, retrogrades, or goes direct?

Outer planets and planets moving in retrograde cycles normally make three passes:

1. Forward motion - you meet an unfamiliar energy, situation, or challenge.
2. Retrograde - you internalize the situation and begin work things out (planet appears to be moving backwards from our viewpoint)
3. Returning to forward motion - you are ready to resolve the situation, and move forward.



What do the transits mean?

Transits are the angles being formed between two planets in motion. They translate the relationship of an energy exchange between two planets. Consider how you work well with some people, while others trigger you. Some relationships promote flow, ease, and harmony, while others offer challenges and push you to your limits. In astrology, some transits promote flow and others bring a sense of urgency or intensity.

Transits are our key to predicting optimal timing. The energy of a transit will come on slowly, gain in intensity, then release. Some transits are felt over short periods of time, while others are felt for months. The time on your calendar is when the transit is exact. Remember that when the transit is exact, it is over. Keep in mind that everyone is unique and experiences transits differently. Here is what we have found to be accurate for our clients:

- Sun, Mercury and Venus - 1 day
- Mars - 3-5 days
- Jupiter 2-3 weeks
- Saturn - 3-5 weeks
- Uranus, Neptune, Pluto - 4-6 weeks

What does it mean when a planet enters a new sign?

When a planet enters a new sign, it's called an ingress. It often feels like there is a changing of the guards, or that a new season has begun. The Moon changes signs every few days, while the Sun changes signs every month. Other planets take weeks, months, and sometimes years to change signs.

Astrologer's Disclaimer: There is no universal way to calculate the Moon Void of Course periods, just like there is no one 'right' type of astrology. Every program and every astrologer has a different parameter for calculating a Moon VOC. If a Moon is considered void in the time after a "major" applying aspect and before an ingress, what is a "major" aspect? To traditional astrologers, that's only the conjunction, sextile, square, trine, and opposition. But to astrologers practicing western, pop, sidereal or one of the other dozen types of astrology, they may allow for other differences. There are likely to be small differences in timings. Even adjusting for time zones, general program errors, and preferences for what constitutes a "major" and a "minor" aspect there will be differences. It is suggested to also keep an astrology journal and notice how you're feeling for particular timing of astrological events. Some people will feel groggy before/after Moon VOC periods and you can begin to identify your personal patterns as they align with the planets.
